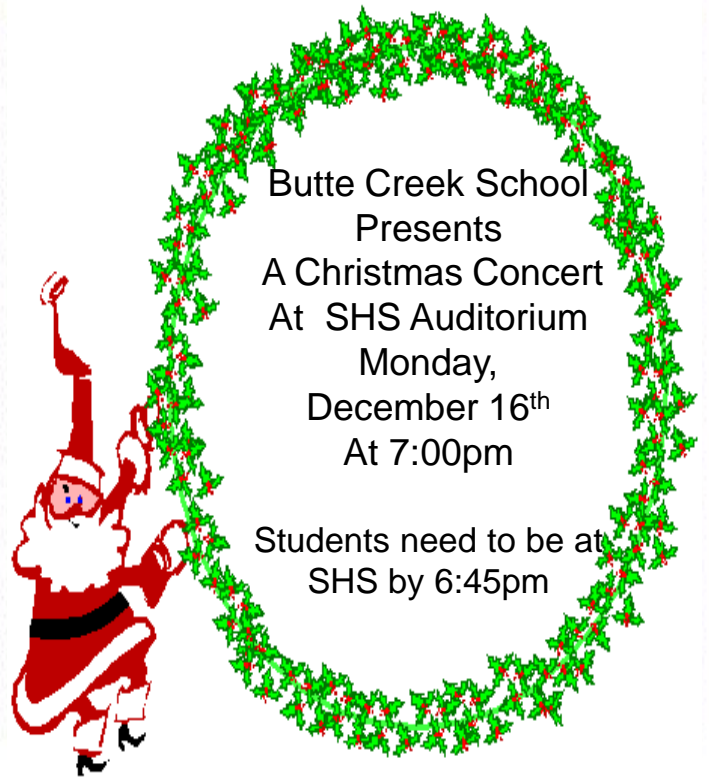

FROM SMOKE TO ELECTRICITY!

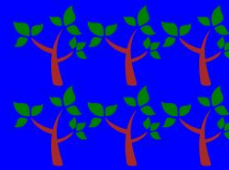
